The Location

Fir Chlis stands on the spectacular West Coast of Harris, the most northerly of the Western Isles, a chain of islands skirting Scotland's north-west Coast, also known as the Outer Hebrides. It is set in the village of Seilebost, 50m from the white sands of Seilebost beach, which are perfect for rock pooling, kite flying and sand castles. Across the inlet, and a great day trip, lies the breathtaking Luskentyre beach, widely held to be one of the most picturesque beaches in the British Isles. The Isle of Harris golf course is 5 minutes down the coast in Scarista. Charter a boat to get a close-up look at the dolphins, seals and bird-life which inhabit the seas around the island. Bring your walking boots, bikes or kayaks to really take advantage of all Harris has to offer.

As well as enjoying the mountains and beaches, visit Calanais, the most significant stone circle in the UK after Stonehenge; St Clement's Church in Rodel, the best preserved medieval church in Scotland after Iona; and the Gearrannan Blackhouse Village, to glimpse what traditional village life was like not so long ago, and get a demonstration of the weaving of Harris Tweed – every piece woven in the home of an islander to this day.

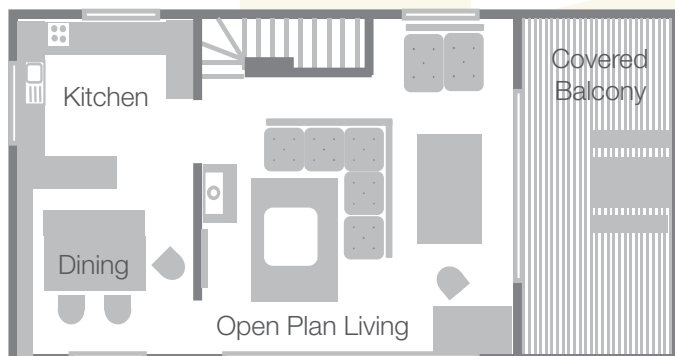


The House

The house is built over two floors, with panoramic views from the top floor, and blends traditional materials which reflect the Hebridean landscape with a modern interior, thoughtfully furnished with relaxation in mind. The open plan upper floor and balcony means that it is best suited for children over five years of age.

The upper floor is given over to an open plan living area with a large covered balcony. Choose a book and sink into the plush sofa, in front of the wood-burning stove or enjoy a drink while watching the shifting colours of the beach or the glorious sunsets over Taransay from the balcony. The lounge has the latest audio-visual equipment installed, and has a desktop PC with Wi-Fi and Broadband connection.

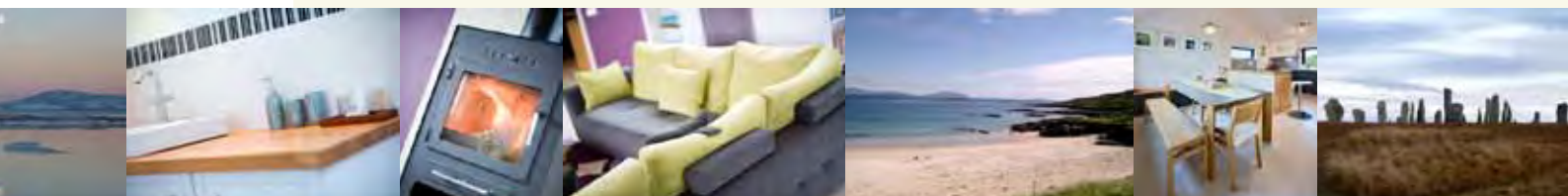
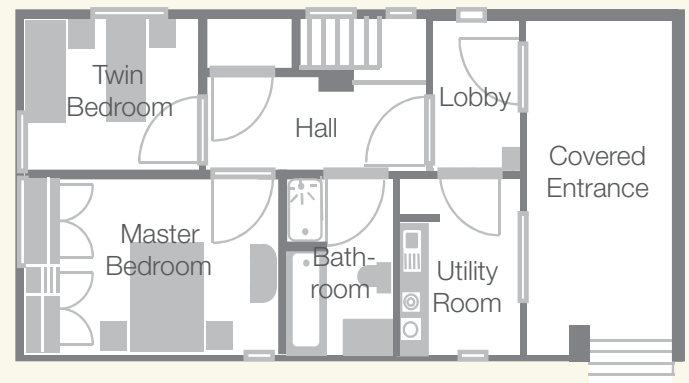
FIRST FLOOR



There is a fully equipped-kitchen and large dining table to satisfy healthy appetites from a day on the beaches or mountains.

Downstairs are two comfortable bedrooms, both with built in wardrobes. One has a king-size bed and the second has twin beds, all with pocket-sprung mattresses. A fold-away bed is available if needed for an additional child. The bathroom has a large deep bath, for those that enjoy a soak and separate invigorating shower. There is a fully equipped utility room with washing machine, tumble dryer, plenty of room for hanging gear and oil-fired central heating throughout.

Getting there

The house is situated on Harris's beautiful west coast, half a mile south of the causeway between Luskentyre and Seilebost, on the A859. It is half way between the ferry ports of Tarbert and Leverburgh (both around 15 mins by car).

There are three ferry routes to the island, all operated by Caledonian Macbrayne. The ferry from Tarbert goes to Uig on Skye (1-2 sailings daily, except Sunday) and Stornoway is linked to Ullapool (2-3 sailings daily with a single service on Sunday afternoon). The ferry between Leverburgh and Berneray (3-4 sailings daily including Sunday) connects with the service from South Uist to Oban.
